



2021 Compulsory Student Services Fees Report

The Compulsory Student Services Fees (CSSF) applies to all full-time students. The CSSF has remained unchanged since 2018, and in 2021 continued to remain unchanged. Each full-time domestic student pays \$500 for a full year programme.

AGI seeks input from all students as to the type of services they desire and does the best as practically possible to implement request received from students.

Students are involved in the decision making of the services made available to them through regular student representative meetings conducted for all the intakes with their Programme Leaders. Furthermore, students give verbal feedback to the Student Services Coordinators and/or Student Representatives and through the formal evaluation of services provided to them at AGI, by means of student surveys. Through these multiple touch points, AGI follows best practice to gather information from students and offer them a wholesome experience while remaining firmly on the path of continuous improvement in the services and support delivered to students.
