What type of device do you need?

Laptops are AKA's preferred device. It is important that your laptop operates effectively in the AKA BYOD environment. We therefore recommend the following:

If purchasing new, the following minimum requirements should be met:

- Windows 11 (or Mac OS 12 Monterey or higher)
- Intel Core i5 / AMD Ryzen 5 / Apple M1 processor or equivalent
- 8GB RAM
- 256GB or greater hard drive
- Wireless capability 802.11ac (Wi-Fi 5) or newer
- 13 inch screen or larger
- Up-to-date antivirus software
- Battery life of a minimum of 8 hours (you will not be able to charge your device in class)

If you currently have a laptop, the following minimum requirements should be met:

- Windows 10 or higher (or Mac OS 10.15 Catalina or higher)
- CPU meets vendor OS minimum requirements at 1.6 GHz (2-core) or faster
- 8GB RAM
- 128GB or greater hard drive
- 10 inch screen or larger
- Wireless capability 802.11ac (Wi-Fi 5) or newer
- Up-to-date antivirus software
- Battery life of a minimum of 6 hours (you will not be able to charge your device in class)
