Recommended to hold one of the following qualifications, or equivalent knowledge, skills and experience. \*

- Have completed certificate in Healthcare Level 3; OR\*
- Successful completion of NCEA Level 2 or 3; OR\*
- Other equivalent education; OR\*
- Appropriated work experience in the healthcare sector.
